Indefinite and Definite Sentences

Aggravated Felony 1	Indefinite term of: 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10 to 25 years <i>Repeat offender</i> 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 or 15 to 25 years
Aggravated Felony 2	Indefinite term of: 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8 to 15 years <i>Repeat offender</i> 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12 to 15 years
Aggravated Felony 3	Indefinite term of: 2, 3, 4 or 5 to 10 years <i>Repeat offender</i> 5, 6, 7 or 8 to 10 years
Felony 1	Indefinite term of: 4, 5, 6 or 7 to 25 years
Felony 2	Indefinite term of: 2, 3, 4 or 5 to 15 years
Felony 3 Non-Violent	Indefinite term of: 2, 2 ½, 3 or 4 to 10 years Definite term of: 1, 1 ½ or 2 years
Felony 4 Non-Violent	Indefinite term of: 1 ½, 2, 2 ½ or 3 to 5 years Definite term of: ½, 1 or 1 ½ years

House Bill 86 9/30/2011 to 3/22/2019

All definite stated terms

Felony 1	3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 years
Felony 2	2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8 years
Felony 3	9 months, 1, 1 ½, 2, 2 ½, 3, 3 ½, 4, 4 ½ or 5 years
Felony 4	6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 or 18 months
Felony 5	6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12 months

Senate Bill 201 3/22/2019 to Present

Changed F1 and F2 offenses to Indefinite terms

Felony 1	3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 years to Max = additional 50% of minimum
Felony 2	2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8 years to Max = additional 50% of minimum
Felony 3	9 months, 1, 1 ½, 2, 2 ½, 3, 3 ½, 4, 4 ½ or 5 years
Felony 4	6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 or 18 months
Felony 5	6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12 months
